I refer to Robins Brook's RPR/10/104
of the 3rd April, with attached correspondence.

This no doubt arises from our request
to N.I.D for facilities to obtain personal
information about leading members of the
R.S.D.L.N., on which I wrote to CD/S on the
16th March. (ACD/79/7368). You advised that
back to me with the word "Yes".

(I attach a copy of ACD/79/7368 for your
convenient reference.)

The argument for FOXLEY and FOXLEY II
was basically the disorganisation that these
operations, if successful, would have caused
in the G.I.A.

as the G.I.A. had probably been fairly
well disorganized since by other events,
I think the balance of advantage would not
lie in trying to catch R.S.D.L.N. officials of the
Kultenrunner type, alive.

I may say in passing that I think the
argument in the third paragraph of Robertson's
letter is not quite sound, as there might well
be circumstances in which assassination was
possible, but arrest was not possible.

However, I advise that we give the necessary
reassurance and I suggest for your consideration
your reply to Robin Brook on the following
lines:

"I refer to your RPR/10/104 of the 3rd April.
with attached correspondence. The FOXLEY
operations were considered at a time when it was
thought that a certain thinning of the ranks

I have been called by I.J.D. who says we have now obtained an S.M.P Cabinet at high level, Operation FOXLEY XII, which applies to the proposed assassination of senior Nazi officials.

We get high authority for Operation FOXLEY but there was some doubt as to its wisdom in some places and it may be that the greater the risk the lesser.

It will suffice I think, if I inform I.J.D. that we have generally, authority to proceed on FOXLEY lines and approval of the major FOXLEY operation obviously including the lesser.

APPENDIX II.

1. In XP/20/24 it was suggested that FOXLEY II be extended to include BORMANN, GOEBBELS, GOERING, KALTENBROOKER and any others whose names I might care to submit.
2. In addition to the above persons I would suggest that certain less prominent lights of the SS hierarchy - potentially more dangerous on account of their comparative youth and the active part they might well play in any Nazi underground movement - be included.
3. These persons are in all cases high ranking SS officers in charge of various Hauptstafette of the SS or of departments in the Reichssicherheitshauptamt (ReSHA). With one or two exceptions they are still, it is believed, all located in Berlin or its suburbs, and offer a considerably easier target than HITLER, HESSLER or GOEBBELS for example.
4. The relationship of the various SS-Hauptstafette, the ReSHA, and the Ordnungspolizei with the Allgemeine SS, the other SS and the police is shown diagrammatically in Appendix I.
5. The names of the above key-men and the offices they hold are given in Appendix II. Part from future considerations, the elimination of some of the above would probably have an immediate and marked effect on Party morale.
6. Photographs and/or descriptions of certain of these persons are already in our possession, and it is hoped shortly to complete the list together with any changes in address (office and residential), as well as to obtain information on the daily routine, habits, etc., of these persons.
7. In view of the apparent tardiness in withdrawing PIs. from West Prussia it is possible that ... and Ruh. offices may remain in Berlin and only be withdrawn to south Germany at the last moment, although there is already evidence that archives were removed some time ago.
