SUBJECT: REPORTS WRITTEN BY DR. WILHELM VOSS.

1. Whilst detained at Dustbin the above mentioned subject produced two reports :-

- (a) SKODA COMBINE
- (b) BRUENNER WAFFEN COMBINE

copies of which are attached.

2. This office has received requests that the following questions please be put to Dr. VOSS, who it is believed is now held by I.M.T. Nuremberg:-

- (a) More details of the mines mentioned in paragraph 3 of the report on special developments and special production of SKODA COMBINE.
- (b) More details of the compasses mentioned in paragraph 3 of the report on the BRUENNER COMBINE.
- (c) If the SKODA and BRUENNER COMBINES provided technicians to supervise the emplacing of the various Coast Defence and heavy static guns supplied to Czechoslovakia and other countries. If so, can he supply the names and addresses of any members of the Combines who did this work, and who can give details of exact locations and battery lay-outs regarding :
 - (i) Coast Defence Guns in any country.
 - (ii) Heavy static guns on either side of German-Russian Front.

3. We shall be grateful if you would kindly forward this questionnaire to the appropriate authorities who are at present responsible for Dr. VOSS.
