AMBASSADOR. MY PRESENT PLAN IS TO MAKE SECOND APPROACH TO PRIME MINISTER DECEMBER 15, ASSUMING HE DOES NOT REPEAT NOT GET IN TOUCH WITH ME SOONER. IF RESPONSE FROM PRIMIN IS NOT SATISFACTORY, I INTEND TO FOLLOW UP IMMEDIATELY SEEKING A VERY EARLY APPOINTMENT WITH PRESIDENT PARK.

5. TO KEEP THE PRESSURE ON ROXG, I SENT TO BOTH THE PRIME MINISTER AND THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER TODAY (DEC. 11) MEMORANDUM ON ECONOMIC AND TECHNICAL ASPECTS DRAWN FROM VERY HELPFUL INFORMATION IN REF D.
