1 BRITISH CHARGE STURDY APPROACHED ECON COUNSELOR TODAY WITH INQUIRY ON STATUS OF KORI II. HE INDICATED THAT GE OF ENGLISH WAS TO SUPPLY EQUIPHENT AND THE EXPORT CREDIT GUARANTEE DEPARTMENT (ECGD) WAS SCHEDULED TO PROVIDE 5200 MILLION IN 15 YEAR CREDITS. HOWEVER, FURTHER DELAY IN CONSTRUCTION AND PRICE RISES WOULD REQUIRE A SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN CREDITS WHICH THE ECGD WOULD BE UNABLE TO PROVIDE.

2, STURDY INDICATED HE HAD HEARD WE HAD RAISED THE LEVEL OF OUR COJECTIONS TO THE FRENCH REPROCESSING FACILITY. WE INDICATED THAT WE HAD DONE SO. WE MADE NO MENTION OF DUR CURRENT APPROACH (THOUGH WE WOULD BE WILLING TO DO SO IF THE DEPARTMENT WISHES), BUT NOTED THE SERIOUSNESS WITH WHICH THE USG VIEWED NATIONAL REPROCESSING FACILITIES.
