The Ambassador of the German Democratic Republic to Pyongyang, Franz Everhartz, mentioned to Ambassador Dumitru Popa that the Korean Committee for Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries informed heads of diplomatic missions in the DPRK of the Socialist Republic of Czechoslovakia, the People's Republic of Hungary and the German Democratic Republic, of the [North] Korean request that delegates from the Ministry of Higher Education visit Prague, Budapest and Berlin for documentation purposes.
