Dear Howland:

It seems to me desirable that you should have as a matter of record a brief written confirmation of the Agency's commitments regarding the recently approved four-part capital expansion program for Radio Liberty. This program includes (1) redesigning and rebuilding the [redacted] at Lampertheim, (2) installing [redacted] at Lampertheim, (3) installing [redacted] in Spain, and (4) installing four new [redacted] at Taipei.

To enable you to incur obligations with manufacturers, suppliers and other third persons, I am pleased to tell you that you may consider Agency funds available to the Committee in the total sum of [redacted]. You have already been advised of the arrangements made for the ultimate accountability of this money.

If you will sign below, it will indicate your acquiescence and acceptance of the amount for the purpose named and also verify the fact that the Committee has already begun to implement this approved expansion.
