## 1' (C) ENTIRE TEXT'

2. DURING A SESSION WITH AMBASSADOR KIM YONG SHIK TODAY, I REVIEWED THE SOLARZ PROBLEM, POINTING OUT THAT EVEN IF HIS VISIT TO NORTH KOREA WAS DELAYED IT ALMOST SURELY WOULD TAKE PLACE SEFORE MUCH LONGER. I SAID I SHARED THE SOUTH KOREAN CONCERN THAT THE VISIT COULD BE SEEN AS MUCKING UP THE NORTH/SOUTH KOREAN DIALDGUE AT A DELICATE TIME, BUT SOLARZ HAD HIS OWN REASONS FOR WANTING TO GO AND IT WOULD BE FOOLISH TO TRY TO BLOCK HIM OR ANNOY HIM. THUS, IF HE WENT I SUGGESTED THAT HE FIRST COME TO SEOUL AND HAVE A GOOD VISIT WITH ROKG OFFICIALS WHO COULD EXPLAIN THE ROKGIS FOLICY.

THE CONGRESSMAN. NONE OF US CAN MAKE THE SOUTH HE SOUTH HE SOUTH HE SOUTH HE AGO, SEEMED WITH THE MATTER SOMETIME AGO, SEEMED VERY RELAXED. HE SAID HE AGREED WITH ME. I M LUNCHING WITH THE FOREIGN MINISTER NEXT WEEK AND WILL OD MY BEST TO PAVE THE WAY FOR "A FELICITOUS HIGH-LEVEL RECEPTION" FOR THE CONGRESSMAN. NONE OF US CAN MAKE THE SOUTH KOREANS NOT BEHAVE LIKE ROTTERS. GLEYSTEEN
