Summary:

Assistant Secretary Holbrooke informs the American Embassy in Seoul that Ambassador Kim Yong-sik and the ROK are extremely upset by Congressman Solarz's intent to go to Pyongyang. He emphasizes that Solarz is aware of US policy toward North Korea and would not carry a message from the US during his visit.

DURING ROK AMBASSADOR KIMIS CALL ON ME MARCH A, INFORMED HIM THAT CONGRESSMAN SOLARZ HAD INFORMED US EARLIES IN THE DAY THAT WHILE HE HAD NOT FINALLY MADE A DECISION, IT WAS HIGHLY PROBABLE THAT HE WOULD FOLLOW THROUGH THIS SPRING ON HIS PROJECTED VISIT TO NORTH KOREA. INTOLD KIM THAT SQLARZ WAS THINKING OF VISITING THAY OR BEIJING, PYONGYANG, AND SECULEIN THAT ORDER. I ALSO ASSURED KIM THAT IF SOLARZ WENT, HE WOULD NOT RPT NOT BEICARRYING ANY MESSAGE ON BEHALFLOF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT. WE WERE NOTHENCOURAGING HIS TRAVEL, BUT ON THE OTHER HAND WE WERE NOTHIN A POSITION TO PREVENT IT. WE WOULD ENDERVORE TO SEE THAT HE FULLY UNDERSTOOD
