RATIFICATION

The Minister of Foreign Affairs submitted to Cabinet a recommendation that Parliament should be requested to agree to South Africa's ratification of The Convention on the Prohibition on the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons and on their Destruction (CWC). Cabinet will consider the recommendation during its next meeting which is scheduled for 23 November 1994.
