

FOLLOWING IS STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT ARISING IN PARTICULAR OUT OF AN ARTICLE IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST ENTITLED "NO PLEDGE ON A. ARMS, WORSTER SAYS" REPORTING ON YESTERDAY'S TELEVISION INTERVIEW.

BEGIAS

IN CONNECTION WITH PRIME MINISTER VORSTER'S OCTOBER 23 TELEVISION INTERVIEW CONCERNING RECENT EXCHANGES BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND SOUTH AFRICA ON NUCLEAR MATTERS, THE DEPARTMENT WISHES TO NOTE THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

ON AUGUST 20, 1977, CN INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE OUR AMBASSADOR IN PRETCRIA ASKED THE SOUTH AFRICAN DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS FOR ASSURANCES FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF SOUTH AFRICA CN THREE POINTS:

FIRST, THAT SOUTH AFRICA DOES NOT HAVE OR INTEND TO DEVELOP NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVES FOR ANY PURPOSES, PEACEFUL OR OTHERWISE.

SECOND, THAT THE KALAHARI FACILITY WE HAD DESCRIBED TO THEM IS NOT A TESTING FACILITY FOR NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVES.

THIRD, THAT THERE WILL BE NO NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVE TESTING AT ANY TIME IN SOUTH AFRICA.

THE NEXT DAY, AUGUST 21, 1977, THE SECRETARY OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS ADVISED OUR AMBASSADOR THAT THE PRIME MINISTER AND FOREIGN MINISTER HAD AUTHORISED HIM TO PROVIDE THE REQUESTED ASSURANCE ON ALL THREE POINTS.

THESE FORMAL ASSURANCES WERE REPEATED IN A LETTER FROM PRIME MINISTER VORSTER TO PRESIDENT CARTER, TRANSMITTED ON OCTOBER 13.

Since this has always been, and continues to be, South Africa's policy which it has decided on independently for itself, it is not appropriate in such a context to suggest that "promises" had been exacted.

In reply to questions raised by the United States
Government in regard to nuclear matters, the South African
Government reiterated its long-standing policy, which remains
unchanged. This was confirmed in a letter from the Prime
Minister to the President, and in his TV interview of
October 23, Mr Vorster again repeated his Government's
policy of developing nuclear energy for peaceful uses
only.

Since this has always been South Africa's policy which it has decided on independently for itself, the question of "promises" never arose. E/east of all in the context that promises had been exacted E.
