The Permanent Representative of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and in response to his note FI 311(1) of January 12, 1971 has the honour to transmit herewith a cheque in the amount of \$ 59148.72 covering the contribution of the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations regular budget for the financial year of 1971.

In compliance with the position taken by the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic with regard to certain specific items in the budget, an amount of \$ 3581.28 consisting of the alleged shares of Mongolia of expenditures connected with the repayment and interest charge of the UN bond issue, the maintenance of the so-called UN Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea and of the UN Memorial Cemeteries in Korea, has been deducted from the sum indicated in the abovementioned note.

The Permanent Representative of the Mongolian People's Republic avails himself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of his highest consideration.
