DRAFT RESOLUTION

Delegation of the People of the Republic of China

The Conference,

fully conscious of the serious threat of Communist aggression to the very existence of the peoples of Asia;

having considered the proposals submitted by the Delegation of the people of the Republic of China on the establishment of an Anti-Communist Union of the Peoples of Asia; and

recognizing the urgent need of such a Union for the peoples of Asia in their common fight against Communism;

Approves the said proposals submitted by the Delegation of the people of the Republic of China;

Requests the peoples of Asia represented at this Conference to sponsor the Union and to form national or area committees to act on their behalf;

A Appeals to the other peoples of Asia to consider and adhere to these proposals; and

Decides to set up a committee composed of the representatives of the peoples of the Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, the Republic of the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Hongkong to make preparations for a Conference and to convene it as soon as possible for the purpose of drafting a Constitution of the Union.
