Rajya Sabha Q&A on a Disarmament Conference for Non-Aligned Countires

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Summary:

Transcript of questions and answers between members of the Rajya Sabha and the Minister of External Affairs, Sardar Swaran Singh, on the scheduling and progress of an International Disarmament Conference for Non-Aligned Countries.

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SCIENCE INFORMATION SERVICE

242. SHRI A. D. MANI : Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROAD-CASTING be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that the Science Writers Association in India has suggested the creation of a Science Information Service;

(b) if so, whether any memorandum in this regard has been prevented by the Association to Government; and

(c) if the answer to part (b) above be in the affirmative, what are the details of the memorandum?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION BROADCASTING (SHRI RAJ AND BAHADUR): (a) to (c) The Science Writers' Association of India has made no such representation to Government. However, on the 27th May, 1966, it had sent a Memorandum to the Committee on Broadcasting and Information Media set up by this Ministry, suggesting that 'Science desks' may be established in all the publicity agencies of this Ministry and that a programme for training Science Writers to do the required job might be initiated for which purpose Government should form the Science Information Service as a separate component of the Central Information Service. The Memorandum from the Association is one of the numerous communications received by the Committee from the various agencies interested in its terms of reference. The Committee has not yet considered this Memorandum; but Government will be concerned not with the evidence received or gathered by the Committee but only with its recommendations figuring in its report(s).

(a) whether it is a fact that some of the Indian Embassies are unnecessarily emphasizing food scarcity in India abroad with a view to securing more assistance; and

(b) if so, whether Government have issued instructions to the Embassies not to resort to such methods?

THE M'NISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): (a) No, Sir.

DISARMAMENT CONFERENCE BY NON-ALIGNED COUNTRIES

244. SHR1 RAM SINGH: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any move by the non-aligned countries for convening a world disarmament conference; and

(b) if so, when and where the conference is likely to be held?

THE MINISTER OF **EXTERNAL** AFFAIRS (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH) : (a) At its XX session, the UN General Assembly adopted a resolution, which endorsed the proposal of the Second Nonaligned Nations Conference for the convening of a World Disarmament Conference to which all countries would be invited. The resolution urged that the necessary consultations be conducted with all countries for the purposes of establishing a widely representative Preparatory Committee which would take appropriate steps for the convening of the conference not later than 1967.

(b) Certain consultations are being undertaken by the non-aligned nations on this question but no decisions have been reached in regard to the establishment of the Preparatory Committee or the date or venue of the proposed conference.
