Dear Mr. Prime Minister:

In your letter of 28 March 1954 you raise several fundamental questions relating to Seoul property used by the Eighth Army and other UN Forces. I am keenly aware of the importance of this subject in an area where housing is so critically short. However, as this subject is one which effects all UN Forces and not merely the Eighth Army, I shall have to delay my reply, pending further coordination. Consequently, I shall limit myself for the present to acknowledging your letter, and assuring you that a more detailed reply will be shortly forthcoming.
