Last September, through the courtesy of the Eighth Army, arrangements were made for the assignment of Private First Class Thomas John, 23rd Infantry Regiment, to temporary duty in Seoul in order that he might assist Korean Army Engineers in designing the interior of the Bando Hotel which is being rehabilitated by the Korean Government.
