Dear Mr. Yu:

The following schedule is planned for the visit by the President and General Taylor to Pusan on LL January:

0830-Depart K-16 for K-9 (Pusan) via C-47
1000-Arrive K-9, depart for reconstruction and rehabilitation installations at various points in the city via Sedan. This tour of visits will include a 20 minute ceremony at the Tonguae Housing area with remarks by General Coulter and the Minister of Home Affairs; and a 30 minute ceremony at the Quonset area to include remarks by President Rhee, General Taylor, and Mr. Wood.; and a Mr.

General Taylor will not accompany the President to the ceremony at the dredge site in Kunsan; it will be necessary for him to instead remain in Pusan for a conference. His Aircraft, the C-47, will be at President Rhee's disposal for the trip to Kunsan and on to Seoul. In this connection, the following further itenerary is offerred:

1425-Arrive K-8, honor guard
1435-Depart K-8 for dredge site via Sedan
1505-Arrive dredge site, ceremony
1550-Depart dredge site for K-8 via Sedan
1620-Arrive K-8, depart for K-16 via C-47
1715-Arrive K-16, depart for Kyung Mu Dai via Sedan
1735-Arrive Kyung Mu Dai
