Letter, Carlos P. Garcia to Young Kee Kim

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Summary:

Secretary Garcia passes on the message from President Magsaysay to President Rhee, which expresses appreciation for Rhee's message regarding the 10th Anniversary of Filipino independence.

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Manila, July 5, 1956

Excellency:

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of Your Excellency's note of July 3, 1956, requesting the transmittal of the therein quoted message of His Excellency President Syngman Rhee on the occasion of the Tenth Anniversary of Philippine Independence.

On instructions of the President, I would appreciate it highly if Your Excellency could convey the following acknowledging message of President Magsaysay to President Rhee:

"I ACKNOWLEDGE WITH MOST SINCERE APPRECIATION YOUR EXCELLENCY'S KIND MESSAGE ON THE OCCASION OF THE TENTH ANNIVERSARY OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE. IT IS MY EARNEST HOPE THAT THE FRIENDLY TIES WHICH BIND OUR TWO PEOPLES WILL BE MAINTAINED AND STRENGTHENED"
