FROM: The President

I have received your reports No. 42 and 43, dated August 17; No. 44, dated August 20; and No. 45 dated August 21, and thank you for them.

I appreciate having the information which you relayed on the withdrawal of American ground forces from Japan, on the preparations being made in Japan for the forthcoming United Nations General Assembly meetings, and other subjects.

With regard to the clash between Korean detainess and Japanese camp authorities, I shall await the report on your investigation of this unfortunate incident. I have instructed the Foreign Minister and the Minister of Home Affairs to investigate and give careful consideration to the activities of Korean residents in Japan who visit Korea.

I have reviewed your report on the 16th Preliminary Session and have no further instructions at this time.
