Proposed by Mr. Amir Alai (Iran)

Seconded by Prince Takeda (Japan)

Considering that the attainment of universality is within the spirit of the Constitution of the Asian Games Federation as well as the World Olympic Movement;

Taking into account the fact that the People's Republic of China, with a population of 800 million people, has so far not participated in the Asian Games Federation;

Further considering that without the participation of the People's Republic of China, the Asian Games Federation does not fully represent Asia, it is proposed that: the All-China Sports Federation should represent China in the Asian Games Federation.
