1. DURING FEBRUARY 28 MEFTING WITH PRESIDENT PARK ON OTHER MATTERS (WHICH WILL BE REPORTED SEPTEL) I INFOPMED HIM OF SURSTANCE REFTEL. SINCE FOREIGN MINISTER PARK IS OUT OF COUNTRY WE WILL NOT PASS MESSAGE TO FOREIGN MINISTRY.

PRESIDENT PARK WAS APPRECIATIVE BOTH OF BEING INFORMED OF EXCHANGES WITH KIM IL SUNG AND FOR SUBSTANCE OF OUR POSITION. HE WELCOMED CONSISTENCY OF US POSITION REFUSING DIPECT CONTACT WITH NORTH KOREA AND IN PARTICULAR PEAFFIRM HATION OF THIS POSITION BY PRESIDENT CARTERIS ADMINISTRATION, SNEIDER
