and branches of the Polish Armed Forces will present their positions and report on the state of readiness of the troops. On the 14th of September the National Defense Committee will meet in order to evaluate the state of national preparedness. In the very near future [date unspecified], military personnel on leave will be recalled. Should Martial Law be declared, the following military units are envisioned for operations in Warsaw: The 17th Mechanized Regiment of the 4th Mechanized Division [the 4th Mechanized Division is located in Krosno Odrzanskie], the 55th Mechanized Regiment of the 16th Armored Division [the 16th Armored Division is located in Elblag], the 1st Mechanized Regiment of the 1st Mechanized Division is located in Warsaw]. In addition, the reconnaissance elements of these divisions will be brought up to full strength. At Rynia and Bialobrzegi centers for receiving families of high-ranking officers are being prepared in order to preclude their use as "hostages".
